James Island Charter High School is offering a computer-based summer "Credit Recovery" program for students who have failed a course and would like to recover the lost credit.

DATES, TIMES, AND LOCATION

- Credit Recovery is scheduled from June 15th through July 24th (subject to change based on student needs). Credit Recovery will not be held on July 3rd or July 6th.
- Students can register for up to two (2) credits, but must select one session to attend:
 - Session 1: 8:00 - 9:30
 - Session 2: 10:00 - 11:30
 - Session 3: 12:00 - 1:30
- Credit Recovery will be held at James Island Charter High School in **Room 815**.

REGISTRATION

DEADLINE TO REGISTER: *JUNE 12th*****

 - 8:30 AM - 3:00 PM
 - Guidance Office
- Students will be permitted to register for up to two (2) credits, provided that:
 - The student has previously failed the course with a grade of 50 or higher, or
 - The student has received an FA/61 due to attendance issues.
- The Principal will make the final decision regarding the approval or denial of a request to register for the summer Credit Recovery program.

- ½ credit course: \$50.00

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

1. Courses with an asterisk (*) require that the student **HAS ALREADY TAKEN** the End-Of-Course Examination (regardless if the student has passed or failed the examination).
2. Students must successfully complete all computer-based instruction with an overall average of 70 in order to earn credit. Consequently, the failing grade will be removed from the student's transcript and replaced with a grade of 70.
3. If a student does not successfully complete all work with an overall average of 70 in the allotted time, he or she will not receive credit for the course. **NO MONEY WILL BE REFUNDED IN THE CASE OF CREDIT NOT BEING EARNED.**
4. Students who incur any disciplinary infractions while enrolled during the summer Credit Recovery program may be dismissed immediately. **NO MONEY WILL BE REFUNDED IN THE CASE OF DISCIPLINARY DISMISSALS.**
